



Blind Pyro Rules and Guidelines

Product will be provided to you at the storage magazines near Stasey Field at 9am on Friday, October 10, 2025. There will be a drawing for the order of choosing your “product pile”. Once you choose your product pile, it's yours. You might want to bring a truck or cart there is quite a lot of product to move.

Here are the rules and guidelines:

1. Have fun!
2. You must use all the supplied product in your show and only the product supplied.
3. Additional product is not allowed including fireballs, 1.3 shells, etc.
4. 150 e-matches (max) will be provided. You will have enough e-matches for every individual product provided plus enough to break out cakes, etc.
5. There will likely be between 60 and 90 cakes and at least two dozen single shots.
6. Prepare yourself for a 5-8 minute show. Most teams go ahead and choose their music and script their shows ahead of time and just “plug and play”.
7. You may supply your own fuse, but no additional e-matches.
8. You may supply any type of racks or supporting equipment/props.
9. You are encouraged to provide your own firing system. However, there may be equipment available to borrow. Please contact us at least a week in advance to potentially secure any borrowed firing system components.
10. You will be assigned a lane to set up in. The lane will be 20' deep and approximately 400' wide.
11. Set up will need to be complete by 7pm. You will be asked to be armed and off the field by 7pm.

Lunch will be served at the picnic area at Stasey Field at 12pm. You can purchase tickets for lunch for \$5. You can find more information regarding the meals at:
